

COVID-19: Guidelines for Events Organisers for Geneva based events

Organising an event in Geneva now or in a near future? Please take note of below important information's.

In view of the current situation and the spread of the coronavirus, the Federal Council has categorised the situation in Switzerland as special in terms of the Epidemics Act. This measure should prevent or delay the spread of the disease in Switzerland, thus reducing its momentum.

Events in Switzerland

The Federal Council has banned public and private events. This also includes sporting events and club activities. All establishments open to the public will be closed. Further information can be found under the section '[Federal government measures](#)'.
