








Geneva at one with nature

Sustainability




- Supplied with 100% renewable energy, the city has developed an ambitious programme to meet environmental challenges by 2030.

- Birthplace of the Red Cross in 1863 in Geneva.
- The Broken Chair, a monumental symbol against the use of landmines.

- Around 160 types of cuisine can be found in Geneva.










4 world exclusive museums

- Patek Philippe Museum
 - Offers an extraordinary display of watches
- Fondation Martin Bodmer (Museum and Library)
 - Among the largest private libraries in the world, displaying a rare and original 1200 old Quran








The history of fine watchmaking





- The history of Geneva and the central role of the city in the development of the Reformation movement in 16th century Europe are the foundations of Geneva's watchmaking.
- Reformation: Calvin & Watchmaking
- December 2020, UNESCO recognizes the knowhow of watchmaking, particularly in Geneva and mechanical art to the intangible cultural heritage of humanity. <u>More info here</u>.

A history as dynamic as a Swiss-made movement





- The watch industry is omnipresent in the city.
- Geneva is the city that hosts the largest number of watchmaking specialists (all professions combined) and that produces the most creations worldwide.
- The oldest watchmaking school in Switzerland was founded in Geneva in 1824 and continues to train many professionals in the field, thus perpetuating Geneva's watchmaking know-how.







The power of attraction when it comes to skills



Medical tourism






- The University Hospitals of Geneva (HUG) represent the leading hospital in Switzerland and are internationally recognized in several advanced disciplines.






Drone show


